

## Pre-clinical Directors of Studies Recommended Levels of Supervisions

The following is the recommended level of provision of supervision for various Tripos subjects and 2<sup>nd</sup> MB and 2<sup>nd</sup> Vet MB subjects for the first two years for medics and vets. The general rule is that this would refer to supervision in groups of two or three and it is not absolute.

If Colleges wish to be innovative in the way they organise their teaching, perhaps using a mixture of smaller and larger group sizes, or having extra sessions of presentation, then they must be free to do so, but it is considered that this level of provision will be entirely adequate to meet the students' needs.

It must be emphasised that these are guidelines.
